

Selected Engagement Highlights

Kaduna State Emergency Management Agency (KADSEMA)

During 2025, ASL Consultants supported KADSEMA through a comprehensive institutional strengthening programme designed to enhance preparedness, coordination, and service delivery effectiveness.

The engagement delivered a suite of strategic and operational instruments, including corporate and strategic planning frameworks, disaster management policy architecture, service standards, and performance management systems. These interventions collectively strengthened organisational clarity, accountability mechanisms, and the agency's capacity for anticipatory risk management and coordinated emergency response.



Katsina State Ministry of Basic and Secondary Education (KTSMBASE)

ASL Consultants partnered with KTSMBASE on the development of a structured Corporate Plan and implementation framework, supporting alignment between policy objectives, institutional capacity, and education service delivery outcomes.


The engagement focused on organisational structuring, performance responsibility mapping, financial and donor alignment, and prioritisation of strategic programmes across the ministry's core pillars. This work contributes to strengthening education sector governance and execution discipline within Katsina State.



Kaduna Mining Development Company (KMDC)

For KMDC, ASL Consultants provided strategic advisory support aimed at strengthening governance, coordination, and performance enablement within Kaduna State's solid minerals development agenda.

Support included the development and refinement of corporate and strategic planning frameworks, advisory inputs on performance monitoring, and risk-informed governance considerations to support sustainable resource development and investment facilitation.



Key Outputs Delivered in 2025

Across engagements with KADSEMA, KTSMBASE, and KMDC, ASL Consultants delivered the following core outputs:

- Corporate Plans providing multi-year strategic and operational direction
- Policy Frameworks, including:
 - Kaduna State Policy on Disaster Management
 - Kaduna State Mining and Solid Minerals Development Policy
 - Katsina State Basic and Secondary Education Policy
- Strategic Plans aligned to institutional mandates and risk environments
- Service Charters defining service standards, response timelines, and citizen accountability
- Early Warning System Guidance to support anticipatory risk management and coordinated response

These outputs were designed not as standalone documents, but as integrated instruments to support execution, monitoring, and accountability.

Governance & Performance Outlook for 2026

The operating environment for public institutions continues to evolve, shaped by fiscal constraints, climate variability, security risks, and heightened citizen expectations. In this context, the governance challenge in 2026 is less about policy availability and more about execution capability.
